Site Name: American Chemical Service (ACS) Inc. Superfund Site

Size: 21 acres

Supported Site Uses: Industrial

Existing Site Infrastructure: All major utilities are available at the existing ACS production facility. Several railways surround and intersect the site.

Readiness for Use: In continued use: The approximately 15-acre ACS production facility which is located on the northern portion of the site.

Not currently available for reuse: Approximately six acres undergoing remediation located on the southern portion of site; ground water.



Griffith, Indiana

The site is located in the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana.

SETTING:

- The site is fenced, zoned for industrial land uses, and is mostly in continued use by ACS.
- Surrounding land uses include industrial, commercial, and single-family residential.
- A country club is located northeast of the site.
- Surrounding population: 0.5 mile, 661 people; 2.5 miles, 33,810 people; 4 miles, 107,209 people.

REMEDIAL STATUS:

- Construction of the site remedy on the ACS portion of the site was completed in 2004.
- Soil remediation by soil vapor extraction is expected to continue through 2008.
- Ground water remediation is ongoing and includes the pumping and treatment of contaminants.
