SETTING:

- The site is zoned for commercial and industrial land uses.
- The site is bordered by a mix of commercial, industrial, and residential land uses, including commercial development along State Route 2, and a large auto yard.
- Surrounding population: 0.5 mile, 757 people; 2.5 miles, 6,666 people; 4 miles, 9,241 people.

REMEDIAL STATUS:

- Remedial investigation of the Cam-Or site is ongoing.
- Removal activities to date include building demolition, drum removal, limited soil removal, and temporary capping of contaminated soils.
