Site Name: Fisher-Calo Superfund Site

Size: Approximately 500 acres dispersed over several locations within the Kingsbury Industrial Park.

Supported Site Uses:

Industrial and commercial

Existing Site Infrastructure:

All major utilities are available within the Kingsbury Industrial Park. Existing facilities include the former Fisher-Calo Chemical Plant.

Readiness for Use:

Ready now: Several portions of the site are available for reuse.



La Porte County, Indiana

The site is located in the Kingsbury Industrial Park, La Porte County, Indiana, approximately one mile southeast of the Town of Kingsbury and just east of U.S. Route 35.

SETTING:

- The site is located within the Kingsbury Industrial Park, which is zoned for industrial land uses.
- The site is surrounded by and interspersed with a mix of active industrial, agricultural, and ecological land uses including Roll Coater Inc., Alexander Chemical, a waste management transfer facility, and a wildlife refuge.
- Surrounding population: 0.5 mile, 57 people; 2.5 miles, 3,220 people; 4 miles, 4,958 people.

REMEDIAL STATUS:

- Ground water remediation of the Fisher-Calo site is ongoing.
- Contaminated soils were either excavated and disposed of off-site or treated through enhanced soil vapor extraction.
