The site is located in Fridley, Anoka County, Minnesota, approximately one mile from the Mississippi River.

SETTING:

- The site is zoned for Heavy Industrial land uses.
- Active land uses on the site are industrial.
- The site is bounded on the west by a railyard, on the north and south by industrial manufacturing, and by residential property on the east side.
- Surrounding population: 0.5 mile, 2,590 people; 2.5 miles, 22,560 people; 4 miles, 128,117 people.

REMEDIAL STATUS:

• Construction of the site's remedy is complete, and included excavating and capping a metal shaving bin sump that was the source of ground water contamination. A ground water pump and treat system was installed. Ground water monitoring is ongoing.
