This is the response from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) regarding your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. The response is from U.S. EPA Region 5, Land and Chemicals Division, Chemical Management Branch, Toxics Program Section and contains all records that are responsive to your request. The request, originally dated Oct. 31, 2007, for a copy of "all leachate data submitted to USEPA Region 5 from 2001 to present pertaining to the Wayne Disposal Inc. Site, MID 048-090-633" was modified. On December 4, 2007 during our phone conference, we discussed the form and substance of material that addressed your needs. In response to your preference to electronic copies, such material does not exist. That being the case, we agreed to limit the request to just paper documents from the last three years, 2007, 2006 and 2005. Enclosed is that material together with annual summary records for the years 2003 and 2005 for leachate and leak detectors as we discussed along with an index.

Under the FOIA, you have the right to appeal our determination to the U.S. EPA Office of Environmental Information, Records, Privacy, and FOIA Branch (2822T), 1200 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, DC 20460. The appeal must be made in writing, and it must be received at that address no later than 30 calendar days from the date of this letter. The Agency will not consider appeals received after the 30-day limit. The appeal may include as much or as little related information as you wish, as long as it clearly identifies the determination being appealed (including the assigned FOIA request Number, 05-RIN-000149-08). For quickest possible handling, the appeal letter and its envelope should be marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."

Two copies of a *Bill for Collection* in the amount of \$186.30, which covers the expense incurred in responding to this request, and a *Fee Schedule and Payment Procedures* sheet are also enclosed. Note that payment is due within 30 days of billing.
