The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is proposing to approve a chemical waste permit for the disposal of polychlorinated biphenyls, or PCBs, at the Clinton Landfill in rural Clinton. An investigation by the EPA determined the proposed PCB disposal cell does not present an unreasonable risk to human health and the environment. The EPA regulates PCB disposal under the federal Toxic Substances Control Act. Before the Agency makes a final decision, it will accept comments on the proposed permit at a **public meeting scheduled for Thursday, June 9, 6 - 8 p.m.** at the Clinton Community High School, 1210 Route 54 W., Clinton, Illinois. Written or oral comments can be submitted at the meeting.
