ANNOUNCEMENT OF FINAL DECISION TO ISSUE A CLEAN AIR ACT PREVENTION OF SIGNIFICANT DETERIORATION PERMIT THAT REGULATES GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS PERMIT APPLICATION NO. PSD-TX-1388-GHG

On August 6, 2014, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6 (EPA) provided notice of, and requested public comment on, EPA's proposal to issue a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) major permit authorizing the construction of a condensate splitter facility and bulk petroleum facility near Corpus Christi, Nueces County, Texas. EPA's final decision grants conditional approval, in accordance with the PSD regulations (40 CFR 52.21), to CCI Corpus Christi LLC to construct a condensate splitter capable of processing up to 100,000 barrels per day of natural gas liquids into various grades of petroleum product, a bulk petroleum terminal capable of loading 500,000 barrels per day of crude condensate liquids, and associated equipment for the facility. EPA received no comments concerning the draft permit during the comment period and no requests for a public hearing.
