Subject: Completeness Determination for the Enterprise Products Operating LLC Eagleford Fractionation and DIB Units Greenhouse Gas Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) Permit Application

Dear Mr. Benton:

This letter is in response to your Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit application received in our office on December 23, 2011. After an initial review of your application, we determined that additional information was necessary in order to begin the processing of the permit. We sent notification that the application was determined to be incomplete on April 3, 2012. We received your response, including a revised GHG PSD permit application, on May 16, 2012.

We have reviewed your response and revised application and have determined that it is administratively complete pursuant to 40 CFR 124.3(c). However, this notification of completeness does not imply that the EPA agrees with any analyses, conclusions, or positions contained in the application. In addition, we may need supplemental information on one or more parts of the application before we can issue a proposed permit.

We are drafting a proposed determination and when we issue our proposed decision, EPA will publish a public notice of the permitting action and allow for, at a minimum, a 30 day public comment period. In addition, the documents will be made available for review by the public during the public comment period. EPA will consider and respond to all significant comments in making the final decision on the draft permit and keep a record of the persons commenting and the issues raised during the public participation process.
