The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6 is hereby issuing and providing you with notice of its final decision on PSD-TX-102982-GHG, which the EPA Region 6 initially issued to ExxonMobil for the construction of a new ethylene production unit at the Baytown Olefins Plant on November 25, 2013 under 40 CFR 124.15.

On May 14, 2014, the EPA's Environmental Appeals Board denied review of the petition for review of the permit. *In re ExxonMobil Chemical Company (Baytown Olefins Plant)*, PSD Appeal No. 13-11, slip op. at 35 (EAB May 14, 2014), 16 E.A.D. \_\_\_. Thus, in accordance with 40 CFR 124.19, this letter serves as the final permit decision by EPA Region 6 for the permit. All conditions of PSD-TX-102982-GHG, as issued by Region 6 on November 25, 2013, are final and effective as of the date of this letter.
