The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed your application, in accordance with the Clean Air Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 7401, et seq.), for a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit for greenhouse gas emissions, authorizing the construction of the Domestic Crude Project at the Flint Hills Corpus Christi - West Refinery.

The EPA issued and published requests for public comment regarding the EPA's proposed action on the above application on April 11, 2014. During the public comment period, no comments were received for this proposed action. After consideration of the pertinent Federal statutes and regulations and documents relevant to the application contained in our Administrative Record, the EPA hereby issues the enclosed PSD Permit for the facility described above.
