In accordance with the Clean Air Act (CAA), as amended (42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed your application for a CAA Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) for Greenhouse Gas Emissions permit authorizing the modification of the four boilers at the West Powerhouse in the Victoria plant, Victoria, Texas.

The EPA issued and published requests for public comment regarding EPA's proposed action on the above application on March 15, 2013. During the public comment period, no comments were received for this proposed action. After consideration of the pertinent Federal statutes and regulations and additional material relevant to the application contained in our Administrative Record, the EPA hereby issues the enclosed PSD Permit for the facility described above.
