In accordance with the Clean Air Act (CAA), as amended (42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed your applications for CAA Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) for Greenhouse Gas Emissions permits authorizing the construction of the PET Plant (PSD-TX-1352-GHG) and the Utility Plant (PSD-TX-1354-GHG) at the Corpus Christi site in Nueces County, Texas.

The EPA issued notice of and published requests for public comment regarding EPA's proposed actions on the above applications on October 14, 2014. During the comment period, EPA received neither requests for public hearings, nor comments on either of the draft permits. After consideration of the pertinent Federal statutes, regulations, and the material relevant to the application contained in our Administrative Record, the EPA hereby issues the enclosed PSD Permits for the two facilities described above. The final permits and other key documents relevant to the final PSD permit are also available online at <http://yosemite.epa.gov/r6/Apermit.nsf/AirP>.
