ANNOUNCEMENT OF FINAL DECISION TO ISSUE A CLEAN AIR ACT PREVENTION OF SIGNIFICANT DETERIORATION PERMIT THAT REGULATES GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS PERMIT APPLICATION NO. PSD-TX-1398-GHG

On October 25, 2014, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 6 (EPA) provided notice of, and requested public comment on, EPA's proposal to issue a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit authorizing the construction of a new 100,000 barrels per day (bbl/day) condensate splitter in Corpus Christi, Nueces County, Texas. EPA's final decision grants conditional approval, in accordance with the PSD regulations (40 CFR 52.21), to Magellan Processing, L.P. (along with its affiliates) to construct a new 100,000 barrels per day (bbl/day) condensate splitter at their existing Corpus Christi terminal, to be constructed in two 50,000 bbl/day phases. The EPA did not receive any comments on the draft permit during the comment period nor received any written requests for a public hearing.
