ANNOUNCEMENT OF PROPOSED PERMIT AND PUBLIC HEARING, AND REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT OF PROPOSED CLEAN AIR ACT GREENHOUSE GAS PREVENTION OF SIGNIFICANT DETERIORATION PRECONSTRUCTION PERMIT

Permit Number: PSD-TX-1392-GHG

Public Comment Period October 10, 2014 – November 10, 2014

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) provides notice of and requests public comments on the EPA's proposed action relating to the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit application for the Nuevo Midstream, LLC (Nuevo), Ramsey Gas Plant Expansion project located in Reeves County, Texas. If finalized, the permit would regulate greenhouse (GHG) pollutant emissions associated with the project to add three cryogenic plants at the existing facility which is located at the following address: 231 CR 452, Orla, TX 79770.

Under the provisions of 40 CFR § 52.21 (except paragraph (a)(1)), EPA Region 6 implements a GHG PSD Federal Implementation Plan (FIP) for Texas. *See 40 CFR § 52.2305*. EPA concludes that the application is subject to PSD review for the pollutant GHGs. Nuevo owns and operates the Ramsey Gas Plant, which is a natural gas processing facility in Orla, Texas. Nuevo's core capabilities include gas gathering, treating and conditioning, compression, and processing. The plant currently has three trains (Ramsey I, II, and III) with a capacity of 300 million standard cubic feet/day (MMSCF/D). The proposed project consists of adding three trains (Ramsey IV, V, and VI) each with a 200 MMSCF/D capacity to increase the total plant capacity to 900 MMSCF/D.

Any interested individual may submit written comments on EPA's proposed PSD permit for Nuevo's Ramsey Gas Plant project. All comments must be received in writing by November 10, 2014, or postmarked by November 10, 2014, to Ms. Nevine Salem at one of the following addresses:

EPA will consider and respond to all comments in making the final decision regarding the issuing of the permit. Similar comments may be grouped together in the response, and the EPA will not respond to individual commenters directly.

Additionally, all comments will be included in the administrative record without change, and may be made available to the public, including any personal information provided, unless the comment includes Confidential Business Information (CBI) or other information whose disclosure is restricted by statute. Thus, CBI or other protected information should be clearly identified as such, and should not be submitted through email. Any emails sent directly to the EPA will capture your email address

automatically, which will then be included as a part of the public comment. *Please note that an email or postal address must be provided with your comments if you wish to receive responses to comments submitted during the public comment period and direct notification of EPA's final decision regarding the permit.*

An extension of the 30-day comment period may be granted if the request for an extension adequately demonstrates why additional time is required to prepare comments.

Public Hearing: If EPA determines that there is a significant amount of public interest in the draft permit, the EPA has the right to hold a public hearing. Any request for a public hearing must be received by the EPA either by email or mail by November 4, 2014, and must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Attendance at the public hearing is not required in order to submit written comments. *If the EPA determines that there is significant public interest*, a public hearing will be held on November 19, 2014, from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the following location:

If a public hearing is held, the public comment period shall automatically be extended to the close of the public hearing. The EPA maintains the right to cancel a public hearing if no request for a public hearing is received by November 4, 2014, or the EPA determines that there is not a significant interest. If the public hearing is cancelled, notification of the cancellation will be posted by November 6, 2014, on the EPA's website <http://yosemite.epa.gov/r6/Apermit.nsf/AirP>. Individuals may also call the EPA at the contact number listed above to determine if the public hearing has been cancelled.

Permit documents: EPA's draft permit, EPA's preliminary determination and statement of basis, Nuevo's permit application and supporting documentation, and comments received from the public, other government agencies, and the applicant during the public comment period become part of the administrative record for the permit. In addition, all data submitted by the applicant is available as a part of the administrative record. Final Determination: A final decision to issue a permit or to deny the application for the permit shall be made after all comments have been considered. Notice of the final decision shall be sent to each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final permit decision, provided the EPA has adequate contact information.
