In accordance with the Clean Air Act (CAA), as amended (42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed your application for a CAA Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit for greenhouse gas emissions authorizing the construction of the new Longhorn Gas Plant in Wise County, Texas.

The EPA issued and published a request for public comment regarding EPA's proposed action on the above application on April 3, 2013. During the public comment period, one set of comments were received for this proposed action. We have made administrative, technical and/or clarifying changes in the final permit. In addition, we have included EPA's response to public comments in our Summary of Revisions for the final permit. After consideration of the pertinent Federal statutes, regulations, and additional material relevant to the application contained in our Administrative Record, the EPA hereby issues the enclosed PSD Permit for the facility described above.
