Tenaska Brownsville Partners, LLC Tenaska Brownsville Generating Station Project

Mr. Robinson:

Pursuant to Tenaska Brownsville Partners, LLC (Tenaska) application to the EPA for a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit for greenhouse gases, which was submitted on February 14, 2013, Tenaska is providing one minor change to our Summary of Mitigation Commitments to the Biological Assessment that was filed on September 30, 2014. This minor change is being made at the request of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services (USFWS) in a letter submitted to the EPA dated October 2, 2014. USFWS requested the language be changed to describe that the proposed Northern Aplomado Falcon nesting survey should take place between March and August. Based on this request we submit the following language describing Mitigation Commitments:

- If the transmission line and the water discharge pipeline to the port will be constructed during the nesting period for the Northern Aplomado Falcon (March to August), nesting surveys will be conducted in accordance with the Interim Survey Methodology - Northern Aplomado Falcon (USFWS - 5/20/03). Should Northern Aplomado Falcon nests be observed within the construction ROW near construction activities, work will be stopped, buffers will be established and USFWS will be contacted.
