In accordance with the Clean Air Act (CAA), as amended (42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed your application for a CAA Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) for Greenhouse Gas Emissions permit authorizing the construction of the Tenaska Brownsville Generating Station in Brownsville, Texas.

The EPA issued and published requests for public comment regarding EPA's proposed action on the above application on October 29, 2014 and December 5, 2014. During the public comment periods, no comments were received for this proposed action. After consideration of the pertinent Federal statutes and regulations and additional material relevant to the application contained in our Administrative Record, the EPA hereby issues the enclosed PSD permit for the facility described above.
