I hereby certify, pursuant to my authority as Attorney General and in accordance with Section 3006(b) of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, as amended by the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 (42 USC 6901 et seq.), and 40 CFR 271 that in my opinion the laws of the state of Louisiana provide adequate authority to carry out the revised program set forth in the revised "Program Description" submitted by the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality. The specific authorities provided are contained in statutes or regulations lawfully adopted at the time this Statement is signed and which are in effect now as specified below. These authorities and this certification supplement the previously certified authorities described in my (or my predecessors) certification(s) of March 8, 1995.

The State of Louisiana was previously granted authorization for clusters referred to by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S.E.P.A.) as Base Program, non-HSWA I, non-Hswa II, non-Hswa III, non-HSWA IV, and Hswa I. This Attorney General's statement coincides with the rules addressed in checklists 53, 54, 56, 57, and 61 in the cluster referred to by the U.S.E.P.A. as non-HSWA V, checklists 64 in the cluster referred to by the U.S.E.P.A. as non-HSWA VI, checklists 68, 69, 74, 75 in the cluster referred to by the U.S.E.P.A. as HSWA II, checklists 80-82, 84, and 86-91 in the cluster referred to by the U.S.E.P.A. as RCRA I, checklists 92, 97-100, and 104-105 in the cluster referred to by the U.S.E.P.A. as RCRA II, and checklists 107, 108, 110, 112, 113, 115, 117A, 117B, 118, 119, 120, 121, and 122 in the cluster referred to by the U.S.E.P.A. as RCRA III.

Remarks of the Attorney General

LAC 33:V.4037.A-C, 4053.A and B, 4071, 4085.A, and B are more stringent than 40 CFR 279.46(a)-(c), 279.56(a) and (b), 279.65(a), and 279.74(a) and (b). The state citations state that the information must be recorded in the form of a used oil reuse/recycle manifest that must be obtained from the Department.

LAC 33:V.4093 is more stringent than 40 CFR 279.82(b). LDEQ prohibits the use of used oil as a dust suppressant with no exceptions.

LAC 33:V.4035 is more stringent than 40 CFR 279.45 because the state provides that used oil transfer facility status be contingent upon approval of the administrative authority.

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There is no state analog for 40 CFR 279.10(b)(3) and 261.5(j) because the state does not recognize the class of conditionally exempt small quantity generators. Generators who generate 0-100kg/mth of hazardous waste must meet the requirements of small quantity generators.

LAC 33:V.4029.B, 4043.B, 4065.B and 4083.B are more stringent than 40 CFR 279.42(b), 279.51(b), 279.62(b), and 279.73(b) because the state requires the use of a notification form obtained from the Department.

There is no state analog for 40 CFR 279.82(c) because it is not necessary for the LHWR to include information on other states.

All other provisions are equivalent.
