In addition, States are not authorized to transmit such information to foreign countries through the Department of State or to transmit "Acknowledgments of Consent" (see 51 FR 28678 for further clarification and the instructions for Appendix J of the Revised SCRAM). (2) Hazardous wastes, identified or listed by the State as part of its authorized program which are broader in scope (not in the Federal universe), are not subject to the export regulations. (3) EPA moved the former exemption from §262.50 to §262.70 in this checklist. However, the Agency failed to modify a number of other sections in the CFR which refer to the former exemption by section. This is subsequently corrected in Revision Checklist 48 (53 FR 27164, July 19, 1988). States are encouraged to simultaneously modify their code to reflect both the modification of the former exemption addressed by this checklist and the technical corrections addressed in Checklist 48.

Notes: 1) The Administrator of EPA is responsible for granting national variances for the effective date of land disposal prohibitions. The procedures for granting the case-by-case extensions are in 40 CFR 268.5. Since the granting of these variances is based on national concerns, States cannot be authorized for this aspect of the program. States should also note that a number of paragraphs addressed by this checklist are superseded by changes made in Revision Checklist 39 (The California List, 52 FR 25760, July 8, 1987). Additionally, the delegability of certain paragraphs changed in that checklist. Specifically, 40 CFR 268.6, 268.42(b), and 268.44 were also made not delegable to the States. States should either not adopt 40 CFR 268.5, 268.6, 268.42(b) and 268.44 or include these sections, making it clear that the EPA Administrator is responsible for carrying out these portions of the land disposal restrictions. States incorporating by reference must exclude these sections of code from their blanket substitution of "Administrator" with the title of the chief administrator of the State environmental agency. For a more detailed discussion of these issues, see the guidance for the land disposal checklists found in Appendix J of the State Authorization Manual (SAM).

2) Revision Checklist 50 (53 FR 31138, August 17, 1988) amends certain sections of code addressed by Revision Checklist 34, but does not affect the delegability outlined in the previous note. Other related checklists include current Revision Checklists 62 (54 FR 18836, May 2, 1989) and 63 (54 FR 26594, June 23, 1989), and future Revision Checklists 66 (54 FR 36967, September 6, 1989) and 78 (55 FR 22520, June 1, 1990).
