- A A parenthetical phrase in the CFR (i.e. by conducting a comprehensive performance test and submitting a Notification of Compliance) was not included in §305.175, but the omitted phrase, which clarifies how to demonstrate compliance, does not adversely affect equivalency.
- B The following clause "to minimize emissions of toxic compounds from startup, shutdown, and malfunction events" was omitted, but the concept is included in §270.235(a)(l)(i) and does not necessarily need to be added for equivalency.
- C & D The same two clauses as stated above in footnote A & B were omitted in §305.571(b) but need not be added. The state rule is equivalent since the citation to §270.235(a)(l)(i) covers this concept & the parenthetical phrase merely provides a more specific explanation. The state rule contains all essential elements.

G & H - §305.571(b) is equivalent and contains all essential elements. Two clauses in §270.66 were omitted from §305.571(b) which provides a more specific explanation, but the explanation is not needed for equivalency.
