



# Tar Creek Superfund Site Construction Activities Safety News from U.S. EPA Region 6 March 2012



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) continues to implement the Operable Unit (OU) 2 and OU4 remedial actions at the Tar Creek Superfund Site. Our first priority is protecting the safety of the community and our workers. The following tips will help all of us stay safe while construction activities are underway and as we continue to obtain access agreements for chat removal:

- Please **DO NOT ENTER** any of the job site areas where construction or cleanup activities are in progress.

- Please **DO NOT TRESPASS** on private property involved in the cleanup effort.
- Property owners should **ASK FOR AN OFFICIAL PHOTO ID** if someone enters their property and claims to be a federal, state or tribal employee. **IT IS A CRIME** to falsely impersonate a federal officer or employee, or any other public official.
