The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for the above-referenced project. Our review and comments are pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508), and our NEPA review authority under Section 309 of the Clean Air Act.

EPA reviewed the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for Keddie Ridge Hazardous Fuels Reduction Project and provided comments to the Forest Service on March 18, 2011. We rated the DEIS as Lack of Objections (LO). We recommended that the DEIS provide additional information to fully describe climate change monitoring and how aspects of the proposed road decommissioning would lead to improved watershed health.

EPA appreciates the Forest Service's responses to our comments on the DEIS. The Forest Vegetation Fuels, Fire, and Air Quality Report elaborates on the information that was provided in the DEIS about likely trends concerning climate change in Plumas National Forest. We also appreciate the inclusion of a map of roads proposed for improvement, and support the inclusion of applicable BMPs which are listed and discussed in appendix H.
