The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Pettijohn Late-successional Reserve Habitat Improvement and Fuels Reduction Project. Our review and comments are pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act, Council on Environmental Quality regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508), and our NEPA review authority under Section 309 of the Clean Air Act.

The EPA acknowledges the importance of the project's goals to improve forest health and reduce the intensity and spread of wildfires across the landscape and near communities. We recognize the ecological significance of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest and support the inclusion of best management practices and measures to protect old-growth forest ecosystems.

The EPA commends the Forest Service for its commitment to decommission 2.3 miles of National Forest System roads to alleviate negative effects on fish and water quality (p. 20). Additionally, we support limiting operations in spotted owl habitat, which will avoid direct adverse impacts to the species. We also support the best management practices and resource protection measures included in the project design. For these reasons, we have rated the DEIS as Lack of Objections—LO (see enclosed "Summary of Rating Definitions").
