Dear Mr. Henderson:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the document above. Our review is pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508), and Section 309 of the Clean Air Act.

On June 17, 2005, EPA provided comments on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for this project. EPA rated the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR)/DEIS as Environmental Concerns - Insufficient Information (EC-2). EPA's rating was based on potential impacts to water quality and endangered species and habitat, the possible presence of asbestos, and an unclear alternatives analysis. The Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) responds to our comments by including additional specificity on the proposed enhancement and restoration activities, existing water quality, NEPA Tier 2 compliance requirements, and mitigation measures for asbestos, as requested by the National Marine Fisheries Service. At this time, we have no further comments, but underscore the importance of appropriate environmental analyses at the project-level.
