The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the above-referenced Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508), and our NEPA review authority under Section 309 of the Clean Air Act.

EPA reviewed the Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (DSEIS) and provided comments to the U.S. Forest Service (USFS) on October 16, 2006. We rated the DSEIS as Environmental Concerns - Insufficient Information (EC-2) because of concerns regarding cumulative watershed effects. We recommended the selection of Alternative D, or a less harvest intensive Alternative B, as a way to reduce impacts to riparian resources, water quality, soils, and native plants (from noxious weeds). Alternative D also meets minimum habitat levels for forest carnivores, the California spotted owl, and the northern goshawk.

EPA has reviewed the FSEIS and notes the selection of Alternative B without change. We continue to express concerns regarding cumulative impacts to watersheds and short-term impacts to old-forest species, and continue to recommend a less-intensive harvest alternative.
