- Indian Affairs funded Hopi to contract a Wellhead Protection Study, to be conducted FY 2010 2011
- IA funded EPA investigation and source removal at MW-07 - completed

# Remedial Investigation Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Work Plan

- Work Plan to be completed I<sup>st</sup> Qtr, 2011
- Comments received by Hopi and Navajo
   Tribes will be considered in development of final document
- RI/FS Scope of Work will be advertised, awarded, and implemented 2011.

#### RI/FS Projected Time Line

subject to change depending on comment periods and consultation

- December 2010
  - Finalize RI/FS Work Plan
- Spring 2011
  - Start RI/FS Work
- Spring 2012
  - Complete RI/FS Work
- December 2012
  - Select Remedy
- Spring 2013
  - Design Remedy
- January 2014
  - Implement Remedy

#### Scope of the RI/FS

- Area-wide surface radiological survey
- Surface sediment sampling
- Ground water (shallow and deep)
- Ecological sampling and analysis (plants and small mammals)
- Landfill gas survey and monitoring
- Baseline human health and ecological risk assessment

#### Administrative Order on Consent

- EPA and IA are entered into an Administrative Order on Consent (AOC) for performance of the RI/FS.
- Under the AOC, IA will perform the RI/FS with EPA oversight.
- Following completion of the RI/FS, EPA will select the final remedy in conjunction with IA and with input from the Tribes and the public.
