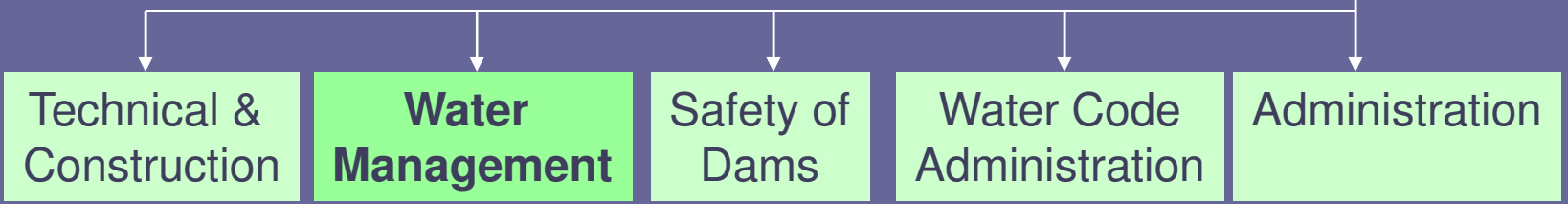

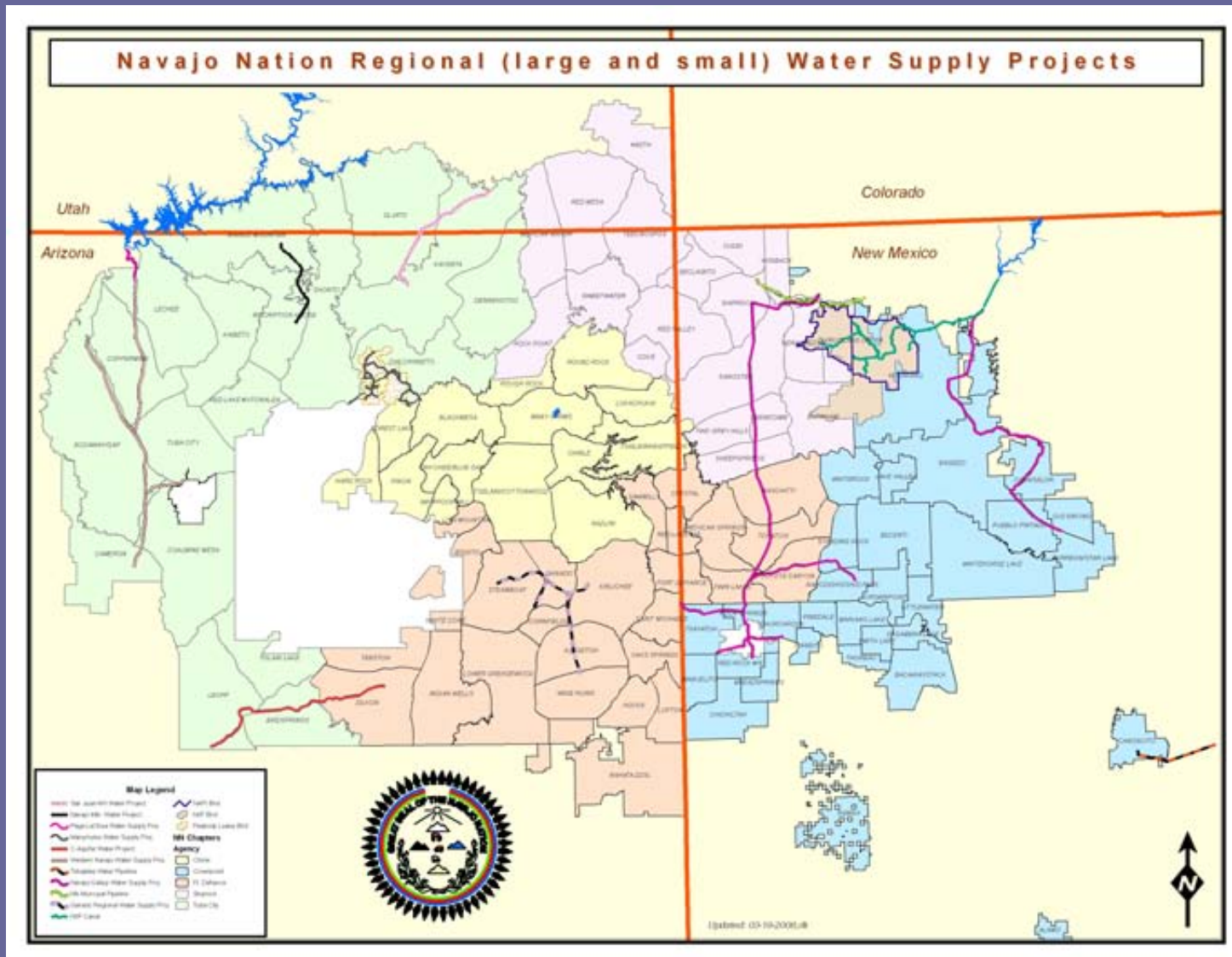
Navajo Nation Facts

- Land Area \approx 27,000 square miles
- 180,462 Population (2000 Census Data)
- By 2040 estimated population \approx 500,000 (DWR)
- Currently, approximately 30% of Navajo homes do not have plumbing facilities.
