

 - Tséhootsooí Medical Center (Ft. Defiance)
 - Gallup Indian Medical Center (includes Crownpoint)
 - Northern Navajo Medical Center (includes Red Mesa and Dziłnaaodiłii) (Dzilth-Na-O-Dith-Hle)
 - Tuba City Regional Health Care Corp. (includes Kayenta)
- Willing to allow your baby to be followed for the first year



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


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
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
