



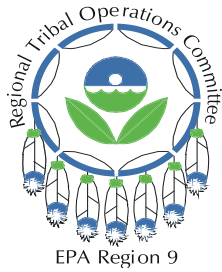

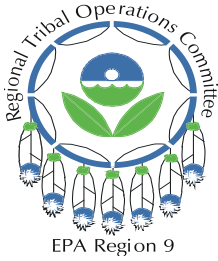

The Huhugam Heritage Center is a place that tells the stories of the history, culture, and language of the peoples of the Gila River Indian Community and honors the ancient Huhugam. It is designed to house and preserve the cultural resources of the Gila River Indian Community, including past and current collections; its goal is to educate the public about the rich cultural heritage of the Akimel O’odham (Pima) and Pee Posh (Maricopa) peoples.
