# What is a Quality Management Plan?

- ► A QMP describes a Tribe's environmental quality system
- ▶ It commits management to establishing a system that ensures the generation of data of known quality
- ▶ It sets out QA roles and responsibilities for all programs
- ► It does NOT take the place of program-specific Quality Assurance Project Plans

## QAPPs, yes, but QMPs?

Region 9 does NOT currently require Tribes to have a QMP, but

- Tribal environmental programs are growing
- Several Tribes have a number of environmental programs
- All programs should follow general quality guidelines
- ► A Quality Management Plan lays out these guidelines

#### Should My Tribe Have a QMP?

- If your Tribe fits the description, you may want to write a QMP
  - Some tribes have either submitted one or are in process
- ▶ It is not appropriate for all Tribes
- ▶ It could be written to represent a consortium of Tribes in a watershed or an airshed

# Quality Assurance Project Plans

- ► Are program specific
- Should be reviewed every year
- Addenda or appendices with new parameters, new methods should be submitted before they come on line
- Should be submitted to EPA every five years

# Laboratory Competency

- The Lab you hire must meet your environmental monitoring needs
- ► Labs demonstrate their competence by
  - ▶ Having a Quality Manual or Plan
  - ▶ Passing a performance evaluation test or tests
  - Participation in certification or accreditation programs

### Bioassessment – Where Are We Now?

- ► A Tribally-convened group met quarterly
- ▶ Trainings were held in the field and in the lab
- Presentations were made at Tribal EPA meetings
