FUNDING AND FLEXIBILITY



- ▶ *General Assistance Program* \$18.7M
- ▶ *Clean Water Act Section 106* \$8.5M
- ▶ *Clean Water Act Section 319 (Base)* \$1.92M
- ▶ *Clean Air Act Sections 103 and 105* \$4M
- ▶ *Solid Waste Implementation* \$3M
