Types of Financing

- Direct and Guaranteed Loans and Grants for Water, Waste and Community Facilities
- Tribal Grant for water/waste
- Colonia Grant for water/waste

Tribal Grant

- Maximum grant per project \$1 million
- Approx \$16 million available annually nationwide
- Per Capita less than \$15,110
- Unemployment Rate greater than 12.75%

Eligible Loan and Grant Purposes

- Construction
- Acquire Land and Rights
- Legal and Engineering/Architectural Fees
- Connection Fees

Community Programs

Regular CF Grant Program

- Average Grant amount is \$30,000
 - California receives on average \$400,000 for the whole state for the whole year.
 - Food related projects and libraries are priorities.
 - Complete application/applications-accepted all year.

Community Programs

Bridge Loans

- USDA funds are not available until after loan closing or start of construction
- Bridge loans cover approved pre-development costs
- Apply for loan after letter of conditions are issued
- Approximately 30 days to secure loan
- Loans are typically repaid at loan closing
