Overview of 172(e) Rule Approach

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- The 172(e) rule refers to AREAS violating
- Applicability

 The 172(e)

 Many nor of counting 172(e) recommoder to the second Many nonattainment areas contain several counties or portions of counties. Do you hold the entire nonattainment area to the 172(e) requirements, or just those portions/counties violating?

• DECISION:

- Maintain the integrity of the existing nonattainment area boundaries for the violating counties within a nonattainment
- County boundaries as a default for unclassifiable areas.

Timing

• How long should the requirements outlined in this rule remain in effect?

• DECISION:

- Requirements remain in effect until the area is designated attainment for the revised PM10 NAAQS.
- For those areas designated nonattainment for the revised PM10 NAAQS, continue to implement the 172(e) requirements until the area has 3 years of monitored data meeting the revised PM10 NAAQS.

Areas which attain based on 1995-1997 data

- Several areas that were in violation as of September 16, 1997 (94-96 data) will show attainment based on 95-97 data.
- Should these areas be required to do more for a standard they are attaining because they didn't make the cut-off date, or should we provide a low hurdle 172(e) for them?

• DECISION:

- A lower hurdle for these areas will be provided for those areas that are currently attaining the preexisting PM10 NAAQS based on 95-97 data.

Areas which do not attain based on 1995-1997 data

- What are the remaining requirements?
- DECISION:
- (1) For nonattainment areas continue to require previous obligations including conformity. Part D NSR will not apply. PSD will apply.
 - Moderate areas continue to implement RACM.
 - Serious areas continue to implement BACM plus any additional measures.

Areas which do not attain based on 1995-1997 data (con't)

- (2) For unclassifiable areas, consistent with Subpart 4:
 - Require demonstration for the purpose of determining RACM for the preexisting PM10 standard.
 - Measures implemented as expeditiously as practicable but no later than 4 years (2002 timeframe--depending on date of final rulemaking)
 - SIP due in 18 months identifying RACM (2000 timeframe--depending on date of final rulemaking),
 - Conformity and part D NSR will not apply. PSD will apply.
