Overview


- ► Issued December 1997
- Reflects Presidential Directive of July 1997
- Grounded in retention of the old 1-hour Ozone NAAQS & Subpart 2 of the CAA
- ► EPA determines attainment Revokes 1-hour applicability when area has clean air quality
- Subpart 1 governs implementation for new 8-hour Ozone NAAQS
- No backsliding -- Maintain momentum of existing programs while moving forward to develop plans for new 8-hour NAAQS


1-HP 03 MAAQS

Revocation of the 1-Hour Ozone NAAQS

- ► EPA determines attainment status and revokes NAAQS applicability on an area-by-area basis
- Based on most recent 3 consecutive years of air quality data
- ► EPA published final revocations based on 1994-1996 and 1995-1997 data; thereafter on an annual basis

Areas Where 1-hour Ozone Standard No Longer Applies





Ozone - Rate-of-Progress (ROP)

- ► ROP means specific reductions in emissions of Ozone precursors of at least 3% per year
- ► Applies until attainment date in Subpart 2
- EPA-approved ROP Plans continue to apply

Ozone - Substitutions for ROP Credits



- States may count emission reductions outside the designated nonattainment area toward ROP
 - 100 km for VOC
 - 200 km for NOx
- Restriction against substituting for required Subpart 2 measures
- Substitution starts with post-1996 ROP Plans
- Geographic limit is entire state for states in fine grid of the OTAG analysis for NOx



Ozone - Substitutions for ROP Credits (Continued)

- Allows credit for reductions from other CAA control measures (i.e., Acid Rain, MACT)
- ▶ No double counting of Emission Credits
- Sources must be added to baseline reduction calculation if from outside NA Area
- Credit may be shared between areas upon agreement

Summary



- 1-hour NAAQS applies until EPA makes a determination and revocation
- Few 1-hour program changes -- No backsliding -- Subpart 2 applies until revocation
- Reclassifications continue where 1-hour NAAQS applies
- ROP for reducing emissions continues ... area for counting reductions expanded to 100 or 200 km outside the nonattainment area for flexability in obtaining progress
- Sanctions & Findings continue
