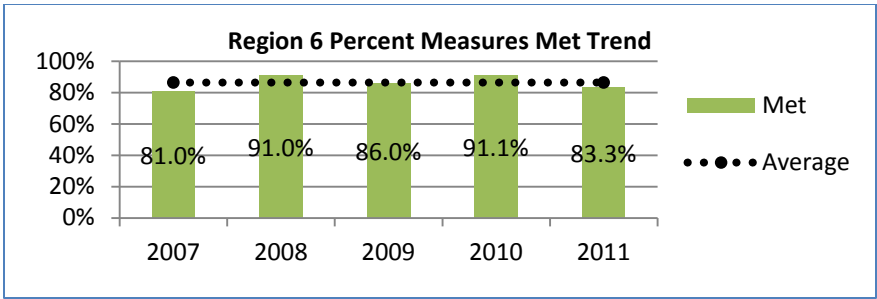

Region 6 Performance Highlights

Region 6 performed better than national performance for the following measures:

- Tribes that have WQ standards approved by EPA (WQ-2)
- States and Territories implementing monitoring strategies (WQ-5)
- Class II wells with mechanical integrity (SDW-7b)
- States and Territories providing electronic information via Assessment Database 2 (WQ-7)

Region 6 fell short of their 2011 commitments for the following key measures:

- DWSRF fund utilization rate (SDW-4)
- DWSRF projects initiated operations (SDW-5)
- TMDLs approved and established by states/EPA (WQ-8a and b)
